Introduction


Since 2003 the First European Elephant Management School takes place at Tierpark Hagenbeck in Hamburg, Germany and will be held on an annual base This 9 day course results out of the idea of Elephant Business and Hagenbeck's Tierpark. Its goal is to teach husbandry, medical care and training techniques on Free Contact & Protected Contact elephants and also to be able to exchange experiences among professional elephant people from all over the world. It combines theoretical lessons with the unique opportunity to gain practical hands-onexperience on the elephants.


Teaching Surroundings

Hagenbeck keeps 10 Asian cows under full contact and one mature bull under Protected Contact conditions. This special environment provides the participants with the opportunity to compare and interact with these forms of husbandry. The differences in safety, husbandry and handling are important matters that need to be outlined.

Curriculum

The curriculum covers a broad variety of all important subjects and is divided up into theoretical lectures and a large scale of practical experiences with the animals themselves.





This subject deals with Elephant Program Design, Working Routine like the Morning wash routine and the Exercise routines, Facility design and maintenand as well as with the appearance of the keepers (e.g. uniforms, dialogue). The Vision and Goals of a proper elephant program are outlined and methods handling and Behavioural Enrichment are presented.

Even Transportation is planned and performed by the participants themselves under professional guidance.











The Medical Prevention Techniques and Body Hygiene include foot care, skin care, tusks and teeth, ears and eyes, tail care, bed & pressure sore treatment, medical training and Veterinary inspections

Medical Procedures are discussed and many cases are presented that cover foot problems, immobilization and tooth extraxtion.

The most important diseases (e.g. Herpes, Tuberculosis and Pox) are presented and treatment and prophylaxis options outlined.








Breeding & Reproduction

The main topics of this task are herd dynamic, fertility control, cycle monitoring, ultrasound, semen collection, artificial insemination and birth (preparations, protocols, caesarean, births within elephant group, handling and training of baby elephants)
